The People’s Action for Free and Fair Elections (PAFFREL), a local election monitoring watch, has requested the Elections Commissioner to announce whether the office bearers of 64 political parties registered in Sri Lanka had declared their assets and liabilities.

According to election law, these office bearers are required to declare
